What is included?

- **2 afternoons of PE lessons per week – each class will receive 1 session of Kixx Education per week.**
Encouraging children to be positive & participate in as much physical activity as possible, improving their fundamental skills, movements & development.
Sports coach being visual, leading, supporting & encouraging more the importance & benefits of PE, sport & Physical activity.
Involve teachers & TA's in the PE lessons, engaging them in activities & developing pupils. Supporting them in delivery of activities & advising them in areas they are unsure about.
PE lessons covered wide variety of sporting activities
Involve elements of competition into all PE lessons for all children, individually & collectively.
- **Hours carried over from Covid-19 Closure – Nurture groups, health and fitness days additional supportive sessions.**
Helping with the return to school adjustments and possible early interventions.
- **2 lunchtime clubs**
Engaging pupils in sporting activities to help manage their behaviour. Developing skills such as teamwork, sportsmanship, respect, communication and coping mechanisms. Trying to establish playground leader roles to create responsibility.
- **1 after school club each week.**
Deliver fun, sporting activities increasing children's participation in physical activity. Encouraging Physical activities outside of the curriculum hours.
Allowing different children each term to attend the afterschool clubs.
Health, fitness & behaviour exercises.
Football and multi-skills club to engage participants in a variety of small- sided, game-based activities, developing activity levels, skills & social interactions.
For all children to develop a want to win but understanding how to lose gracefully. Highlighting the importance of respect and sportsmanship. Participate in competitive games. Always encourage all children to try their best and enhance confidence.
- **Full Curriculum for EYFS & KS1 with key activities covered**
EYFS – Multi-skills and ball skills, Dance/gymnastics, and athletics.
KS1 - Multi-skills, Invasion games, Gymnastic, Dance, Outdoor and adventurous activities (including fitness) and Athletics.
Specialist Dance and Gymnastic Coaches at no additional cost.
Encourage & help teachers with ideas to lead & deliver PE lessons, promoting physical activity.
Access to PE planning, supporting teachers with structures, ideas, notes & examples to lead PE lessons. This is in digital and paper form.
- **Feedback and reports for every Curriculum session delivered.**
This is done on a weekly basis with numerical and written feedback each session.
Explains to teachers on how their children have done in PE. Highlighting areas for improvement & high achievers.
Providing information regarding areas of learning, children's progress & next steps, in which teachers can look out for/ implement into their PE lessons.

- **Support for Competition entry when needed to encourage development**

Provide opportunity for children & teachers to participate in intra-school competition. Expressing, enjoying & performing their skills from PE in front of their grown-ups/teachers. This will encourage pupil, teachers/staff to see how physical activities can involve parent/carer interactions. Encourage them to build new relationships through involvement with different activities, support hearted, competitive sport & community projects. Include different sporting activities & athletics events for the sports day.

- **In house tournaments – inviting other schools for competitive days.**

Allow children attending extra-curricular clubs to compete against other schools. Participate in a local inter- school competition against other infant/primary schools.
