Vocabulary

- **Celebration:** A social gathering or enjoyable activity held to celebrate something special.
- **Bonfire night:** A night where you might see a large bonfire and a fireworks display.
- **Birthday:** Celebrating becoming one year older.
- **Diwali:** The Hindu festival of light.
- **Diya:** Lamp
- **Rangoli:** Lot's of colours made into patterns.
- **Christmas:** A Christian celebration, celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ.
- **Christian:** A person who believes in Jesus Christ and follows his teachings.
- **Birthday cake:** a cake to celebrate someone's birthday.
- **Decorations:** Objects you put up to celebrate a festival or special event.
- **Present:** A gift you give to someone that might be wrapped in wrapping paper.
