Vocabulary

- **Magic:** Something wonderful and exciting.
- **Spell:** Pretending to make something using different ingredients.
- **Witch:** A made up lady character thought to have magic powers.
- **Wizard:** A made up male character thought to have magic powers.
- **Once upon a time:** How to start a fairy tale story.
- **Wicked:** Something really bad.
- **Good:** Something nice.
- **Instruction:** Tells you how to do something.
- **Wand:** Used by witch, wizard or fairy to make magic spells.
- **Fairy:** A made up character who can fly.
- **Castle:** An old building with thick walls and moat.

 - **Who is a wicked character?**
- **What happened at the beginning/end of the story?**
- **Can you make up your own story?**
- **Can you remember the instructions?**
- **Can you create your own spell?**
