Vocabulary

- **House:** A building where people live.
- **Bricks:** A strong block used to make a building.
- **Sticks:** A wooden material.
- **Straw:** Dried stalks of grain.
- **Build:** To construct a building using materials.
- **Vehicle:** A machine that transports people or objects.
- **Rocket:** A spacecraft that travels into space.
- **Astronaut:** A person who works in space
- **Town:** A built up area with lots of homes, shops and parks.
- **Road:** Where you drive vehicles.
- **Builder:** Someone who builds homes and buildings.
- **Construct:** To make something.

- How did the little pigs feel when the wolf blew down their homes?
- What would you build your house out of?
- What vehicle can you name, what do they do?
