Vocabulary

- **Family:** A group of people we may live with, this may be our mother, father, sister, brother, grandmother, grandfather, cousin, aunt and uncle.
- **School:** a place where we go to learn with other students.
- **Nursery:** our classroom in a school.
- **Home:** a place where we live.
- **Body:** naming the parts of our body such as arms, legs, head, feet, hands.
- **Face:** the part of our body where we can see, taste and hear.
- **Rossington:** the village where our school is in.
- **Tidy:** to put something away in the right place.
